Event and Auction Guidelines

We are asking you to please take a seat and turn a chair into a work of art. Enter your chairitable creations in our Chair Affair Auction and help the FOTD continue to provide fabulous community events, maintenance and beautification in the Downtown Area.

Guidelines for Creating a Chair for the FOTD Chair Affair Auction - Questions Call 748-4261

1. As an equal opportunity fundraiser, we define a chair as any suitable type seat: a bench, a stool, a rocker, etc.
2. Chair Affair is open to all ages, artists, non-artists, schools, classes, organizations, or community groups.
3. Chairs may fit within the dimensions of 36" by 36" by 72" - roughly, we're not going to turn you away!
(A bench might be 72" long, 18" wide, and 24" high for example.)
4. Any medium or technique used to create a fabulous chair is acceptable. Additions and enhancements should be well secured. You can paint, peel, papier mache, decorate, decoupage, build, burn, or bend your chair as long as the chair remains structurally sound, safe, and suitable for sitting. Your challenge is to produce a chair that is artistic as well as functional.
5. Chairs are considered donations to the FOTD and will auctioned off on August 19, 2010 to raise funds for the FOTD.
(The FOTD will determine the opening bids.)
6. Deliver chairs at any time during our regular hours with registration form to the Medford Chamber of Commerce Office.
Chairs between June 15 and August 17, 2010. (Earlier submissions are welcome, please call 715-748-4261 for information!)
